

Polar Sulky Repeater

Installation

(See picture of Polar Sulky Repeater in the bottom left panel)

- 1. Open the long tube by pulling both ends.
- Place the 2 LR44 batteries within the black insulation (the spring corresponds to the positive contact). Close the long tube by rotating over 2 O-ring.
- Attach the small tube close to the Polar Transmitter (max. 30cm) by using one cable tie. Wind the cable around the shaft,



- 4. Attach the long tube by using 2 cable ties, side to the Polar Receiver. When your arm is parallel to the tube. maximum distance range should be around 100cm.
- 5. The Polar Receiver can also be attached to the Polar bike mount (accessory).

Trouble Shooting

- If the 00 heart rate readings appear only occasionally, this may be caused by high voltage power lines in your surrtoundings.
- If the 00 readings appear more often, you probably have ridden 4000 hours (1500 hours with Polar Coded Transmitter). You have to change the batteries (2 x LR44) by following the installation procedure (1-2).
- If you cannot read heart rate value at all, check the position of the small tube compared to the Polar Transmitter (3).
